

BOARD MEMBER SELF-ASSESSMENT

This checklist is a simple way to assess your performance as a board member. How do you rate?

- 1. Do I attend board meetings regularly and participate actively?
- 2. Do I read and understand the minutes of the board meetings (even those I miss)?
- 3. Do I serve on a board committee and do I follow through with my committee responsibilities?
- 4. Do I see to it that all committee deliberations are reported to the Board?
- 5. Do I understand how organization policies are created and implemented?
- 6. Do I understand the organization's finances and budgets?
- 7. Do I know the organization's financial condition?
- 8. Do I disclose any conflicts of interest with the organization to the Board on a regular basis?
- 9. Do I treat the affairs of the organization with the same care I would my own?
- 10. Do I ask questions if I am unclear about board discussions or organization policy?
- 11. Do I know if the organization is living up to all the requirement of its nonprofit, taxexempt status?
- 12. Do I know if the organization is complying with the laws of the state(s) that it is operating in?
- 13. Do I monitor the image of the organization in the community on an ongoing basis?
- 14. Do I understand my responsibilities as a board member?
- 15. Do I know if the board has proper legal and accounting representation?
- 16. Do I visit the organization's facilities on a regular basis?
- 17. Do I read the publications of the organization and understand them?
- 18. Can I publicly state my position if I disagree with a policy or proposal?
- 19. Do I understand the difference between board and staff roles?
- 20. Do I know what to do in a crisis situation?
