

Substance Abuse Prevention Coordinator

Position Description:

This position coordinates the PFS (Partners for Success) Grant strategies and interventions and provides leadership and direction for the PFS initiative; reduces underage drinking and youth marijuana use. Reports to Director of Prevention.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Lead a community-based process to develop a regional substance abuse prevention plan and subsequent completion of the strategic plan's deliverables, both required and optional.
- Coordinate youth prevention based program(s) and events
- Lead the Addison County Youth Prevention Group & The UWAC Youth Prevention Program HELP (Health Education Learning Program)
- Co-develop annual regional budget and financial reports related to the grant in collaboration with the Accounting Manager and Director of Prevention
- Execute the social media/media and marketing plan
- Share & deliver substance use prevention data, information & education to key community stakeholders and partners
- Execute the developed sub-granting and reporting process with the Director of Prevention and Executive Director
- Coordinate with sub-recipients and community partners to complete agreed upon strategic plan/initiatives
- Timely and accurate completion of all grant reports (including state and federal) that are in compliance with grant requirements in collaboration with Director of Prevention
- Attend/ Participate in all PFS required trainings & seek optional trainings that enhance and maintain current / trending knowledge of substance use prevention
- Assess community data, emerging needs, issues, trends, best practices and current events as it relates to the PFS initiative, strategic planning and program development
- Develop internal progress reporting system
- Develop and maintain relationships with policy makers, stakeholders, funders, grantees, businesses, schools & community partners to advance UWAC vision and goals particularly as they relate to the PFS action plan

- Represent UWAC at various related community coalitions, meetings and events
- Work with Director of Prevention, Executive Director and Marketing and Development Manager to communicate to the community about these initiatives and results
